

Heavy Duty Staplers

While a smaller machine is usually adequate for stapling 2 to 20 sheets of paper, a Heavy Duty (HD) Stapler, as a rule, staples more. **Much more!**

Being speciality products, HD Staplers tend to use unique staples, which vary in size and leg length. The longer the staple is, the more sheets it can penetrate.

Rexel has two distinct types of HD Staplers: 'single staple' and 'multiple staple' machines, each of which has unique benefits.
